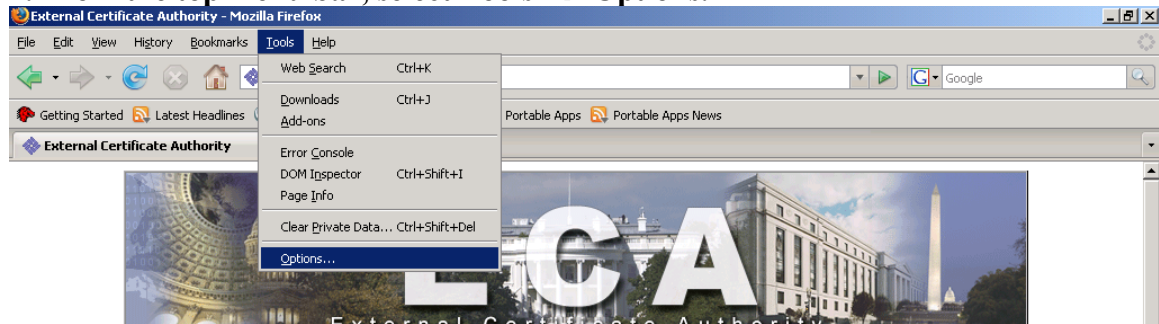


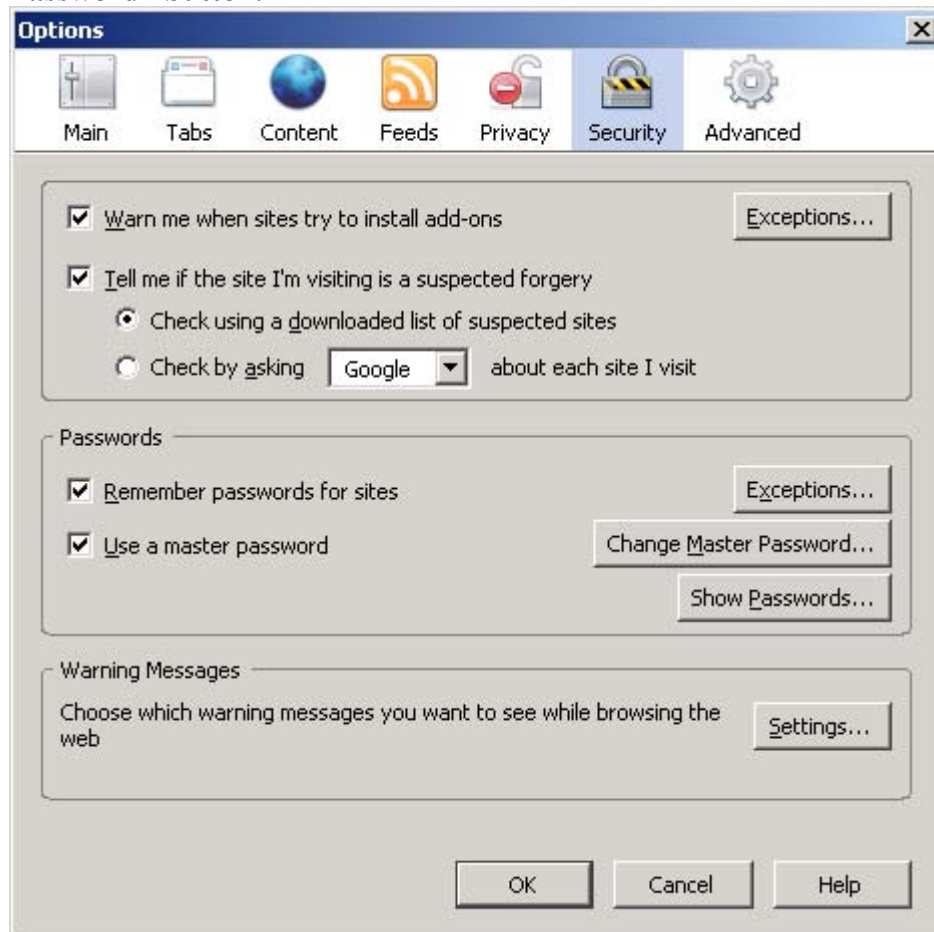
## Changing the Master password in Mozilla Firefox:

1. Open up a Mozilla Firefox Web Browser.

2. From the top menu bar, select Tools -> Options.



2. From the options screen, select the Security tab. Click on the “Change Master Password” button.



**3. Type in the current Master Password and change it to a new and easy to remember one and click OK.**

**Change Master Password** [X]

A Master Password is used to protect sensitive information like site passwords. If you create a Master Password you will be asked to enter it once per session when Firefox retrieves saved information protected by the password.
